### **MINUTES OF THE 2<sup>nd</sup> QUARTER MEETING OF THE BOARD OF ADVISERS**

#### **CALL TO ORDER**

Jim Tiller opened the meeting at 5:30 PM. The following agenda items were addressed:

- Ongoing projects;
- Members' conduct;
- Members' day.

#### **ONGOING PROJECTS**

##### **Steel bays**

Frankie McRae updated the Board on the ongoing construction in the steel bays. Specifically, the discussion addressed the new three-target wide steel pit that was being constructed next to the current steel bay and the shoot house. It was reported that the construction would be completed once the 6-foot concrete blocks required for building the wall next to the steel pit were in. The targets in the pit will be hangers. When the construction is finished, the range will have four steel bays in total. It was also mentioned that after the construction was complete, no steel targets would be allowed in the tactical bays.

##### **Sprinkler system**

Frankie McRae further reported that the installation of a newer sprinkler system was in progress in the 100- and 25-yard bays. Larger pipes were reported to have been installed to increase the volume and get more flow than what the older pipes could provide.

##### **Proximity cards**

Frankie McRae further reported that the new proximity cards for accessing the facility were being handed out to all members. The transition to the new access system will be completed by July 1. The system will allow members to be at the range from 6:30 AM to 9:00-9:30 PM. After 9:30 PM, the gates will lock automatically prohibiting access from and to the facility. A timer will be put on the outdoor lights to cut off at 9:15 PM and, thus, signal members to leave the facility.

### **MEMBERS' CONDUCT**

Next, Frankie McRae expressed concerns about poor conduct of some members and addressed measures that would need to be taken to prevent such conduct in the future. Specifically, the discussion focused on members who shoot in an irresponsible manner violating the fundamental rules of firearms safety and putting at risk other members, staff and guests of the range. The irresponsible treatment of firearms also causes damage to the facility itself, its equipment and grounds. The discussion further turned to members who consistently fail to do the clean-up after using the range. The Board was asked to provide recommendations on what other measures could be taken to eliminate such conduct and assist staff and owners in their effort to make the range a better, safer and cleaner place for everyone. It was decided and agreed upon that additional cameras would be put on site to help identify members whose conduct is unacceptable and requires attention and/or disciplinary actions.

### **MEMBERS' DAY**

It was decided and agreed upon to have the next Members' Day scheduled for September 10th. Details to be followed.

### **ADJOURNMENT**

The meeting closed at 6:30 PM. The Board will reconvene in September for its 3d quarterly meeting.
